**LENGTH OF TOUR:** Date of hire – 30 September 2025; position continuation is contingent upon receipt of federal funding. Selected Soldier will conduct IDT and AT with their assigned unit.

  - Must have a valid passing ACFT at the time of application. If current ACFT is over 6 months, one must be taken and passed prior to onboarding if selected.
